

It is becoming increasingly clear that the needs of the twenty-first century 'learner' demands new approaches to 'learning'. The lack of student voice and agency in their learning has meant that schools around the world still take a largely standardised, one-size-fits-all approach, valuing compliance over creativity, content over character. This narrow approach doesn't set children up well to thrive in the twenty-first century.

Today, student success requires skills for collaboration, creativity, compassion, and problem solving. There is an urgent need to prepare our young people to both navigate an unknown and complex future and in-still in them the belief that they can shape a more desirable, sustainable future. To meet this need, it is even more imperative that teachers and school leaders tap into their own creativity and build this same belief in their own capacity to develop and drive change within education.

The Discovery Visit' takes the shape of an onsite visit which allows the RLC team to gain detailed insights about the people, place and practices of the school. It will involve observations, interviews and informal interactions with all the stakeholders available — teachers, parents, students, administrative and management teams. Following the audit, RLC will provide a report that gives a summary of the observed strengths, areas of development and recommendations.

The visit is the the first step in forging a deeper, longer partnership - and provides both parties: the school and RLC with the opportunity to understand each other's methods and processes.
