## **BANK OF FOCUS QUESTIONS:**

Ц	How many higher order to lower order questions am I asking?
	How long am I spending on the hook and CTL?
	Do I go on a tangent when explaining a connecting concept?
	Is my tone and volume increasing as I answer the same question repeatedly?
	Am I using language that is understandable when explaining the concept?
	How many times do I connect the concept with a real-life example and/or analogy?
	Is my board reflective of the progress made in the class?
	Is there too much noise and cross talk in my class?
	Do I give opportunities for students to work together on a problem?
	If a student has a question, do I answer it for them?
	How do I navigate a question I don't know the answer to?
	How long does it take me to settle the class down when we start, and do I end the class on time?
	On what do I end up spending the most time in my class?
	How often do Lask students to summarize a concept?
